






The water in wetlands varies dramatically month to month and year to year. Waterbirds may respond by moving among different wetlands.






Green –wetlands, vegetation Blue – Lakes, open water Northeast --addressing water shortage






What happens when the same negative factors – prolonged drought and growing human demand for water – threaten all wetlands in a region? Where can the waterbirds go?
